### Notice 2 Attachment #1

## Covid-19 Protocol

Due to the current Covid-19 situation and the regulations established by the Estonian Government, the OA is establishing the following protocol. The Event can only take place if Organizers apply additional appropriate measures and all participants follow them.

CP1. In addition to NoR 4.1 a participant is eligible to if he meets one of the following conditions:

- a. Present a valid certificate to prove that has recovered from Covid-19 or is fully vaccinated.
- b. Present one of the following negative test certificates:
  - i. rapid antigen test done less than 48 hours before.
  - ii. PCR test done less than 72 hours before.
- c. Is under 18 years old.

CP2. A participant who does not comply with the requirements in CP1 shall provide a negative test on August 9<sup>th</sup> at the race office before going afloat. Such a test shall be repeated once its validity expires. The Organizing Authority will make available rapid tests at the venue on August 8<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> in the afternoon with a validity of 48 hours. The cost of the test will be charged to the participant.

CP3. If a participant is tested positive, he will not be allowed to get in the venue and will be subject to the correspondent Covid-19 measures stated by the local health Authorities.

CP4. Participants shall comply with any reasonable instructions given by a member of the Organizing Authority or any official of the event in relation to this protocol.

CP5. Failing to comply with this protocol will be penalized at the discretion of the International Jury.

### Covid-19 related information

#### General

Alexela ORC World Championship 2021 takes place in exceptional circumstances due to Covid-19 restrictions. Organizers follow the regulations given out by Estonian Government. As the number of participants at the Event is higher than threshold in the Government order, the Event can only take place if Organizers will apply additional appropriate measures and all participants will follow them.

For that purpose, Organizing Authority has issued Covid-19 protocol which has to be followed. Non-compliance will be penalized at the discretion of the International Jury.

#### Who can participate

The participants are eligible to attend the Event if they meet one of the following conditions:

- 1) Recovered from Covid-19 or fully vaccinated and can present a valid certificate to prove it
- 2) Present one of the following negative test certificates
  - a. rapid antigen test done less than 48 hours ago
  - b. PCR test done less than 72 hours ago
- 3) Under 18 years of age

#### Testing at the Event

Rapid antigen testing is possible at the Event in the afternoons of 8th, 10th and 12th of August. The cost of testing will be paid by the participants themselves.

#### How to?

- All participants need to present valid certificate or negative test result personally during the registration at the Race Office
  - All fully vaccinated participants will receive additional wristband during the registration to speed up further checks by the organizers.

- Participants who are not fully vaccinated, must present their negative test certificate at the Race Office latest in the morning of 9th of August before going afloat.
- Participants whose test validity expires, shall present their negative test certificate at the Race Office each time after re-testing.
- If person is tested positive, he shall not be allowed to attend the Event

**Who are considered vaccinated or equal to vaccinated**

- 1) Person has completed the vaccination series of Covid-19 less than year ago
- 2) Person has recovered from the Covid-19 and received one dose of vaccine less than year ago
- 3) Person has recovered from Covid-19 less than 180 days ago
